We gather this weekend to celebrate the Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time. The readings are Job 38:1, 8-11, Second Corinthians 5:14-17 and Mark 4:35-41.

In the first reading, after listening to Job and his friends complain and try to figure out why Job lost everything, the Lord tells Job that he and his friends do not know everything. He tells Job that He set boundaries for the sea, controlling its limits and waves, He takes care of everything. In the second reading we are being told that Christ's love leads us to live for him, not for ourselves. In Christ, we become a new creation, leaving the old behind. In Mark's Gospel, Jesus calms a storm after his disciples wake him in fear. He questions their faith, and they are amazed that even the wind and sea obey him. The theme of this week's readings is trying to show us how much God loves us and that we need to trust him.

We have begun a new class OCIA, (formally called RCIA) for those interested in joining the Church. We will meet on Tuesday evening at 7 pm in the Parish Center. The class will meet for about an hour during the summer months. If you would like to take the class, please call the Parish Office to let us know if you are interested or come to the Parish Center on Tuesday evening.

TIDBITS OF OUR CATHOLIC FAITH

What did St. Michael say to Satan?

Serviam is a powerful prayer for Catholics. But where did it come from?

Serviam is a quick and easy motto that every Catholic can embrace.

The use of this motto was inspired by the story of St. Michael the Archangel and his battle against the fallen angels. As Scripture tells us: Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon — Revelation 12:7

It is traditionally believed that Satan said to God, “*Non serviam!*” which means, “I will not serve!” Satan wanted to *be* God—not *serve* God.

When St. Michael witnessed this, he was filled with righteous indignation on behalf of His Creator and is believed to have cried out: “Who is like God?!” Hence his Hebrew name, *Mikha’el*, which means *Who is like God?* It’s a rhetorical cry—one that means, “*No one is like God!*”

Satan rebelled and lost his place in heaven, but Michael chose to serve God, and is now Prince of the Heavenly Hosts. In imitation of the Archangel’s faithful service to God, we can say “*Serviam!*” when we are tempted, or discouraged, or overwhelmed. “*Serviam, Lord!*”

Saying *Serviam!* is a fast and effective way to remember the One we serve. It also reorients us to follow God’s will, especially in moments of temptation, just as St. Michael the Archangel did.

Several morning offering prayers include the motto *Serviam*, asking God to help us love and serve Him faithfully throughout our day.

You can also ask for St. Michael’s intercession through the prayer below:

*St. Michael the Archangel,
Defend us in battle.
Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of
the devil.
May God rebuke him, we humbly pray.
And do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Hosts,
By the power of God,
Cast into Hell Satan, and all the evil spirits,
Who prowl throughout the world, seeking the ruin of
souls. Amen.*
